SCHOLARSHIPS AND DISCOUNTS

- **Discounts to ACG Alumni**

All ACG Alumni with an undergraduate degree are entitled to a 10% tuition fee discount.

- **Scholarships:**

All candidates with an undergraduate degree GPA over 3.5 are entitled to receive a Merit Scholarship*

Graduate applicants from the UK who have GPA of 2:1 (upper2nd class) and above, typically qualify for a scholarship, however, the percentage will be determined based on the candidate's transcripts and university.

*Scholarships do not apply for Graduate Certificate Programs.

- **Corporate Discounts:**

Group size	Tuition Discount
2-3	15%
4-5	20%
6+	30%

- Groups must be comprised by employees of the same organization. A group does not necessarily need to be fully sponsored by the organization. However an official representative of the organization needs to act as the point of contact between the College and the company and to sign the relevant agreement between the two institutions.
- The discount rate will be adjusted to the next level for the whole group when an organization increases the number of participants in the scheme
- The maximum tuition discount that may be applied for candidates who are eligible for both a merit scholarship and a corporate discount is 50%.

DEREE Academic Advising Office: While at DEREЕ Study Abroad students who need assistance with academic matters must contact the Academic Advising Office (dc.adv@acg.edu)

DEREE Academic Policies: Study Abroad students must abide to all DEREЕ academic policies as they are printed in the *Undergraduate Online Catalogue* located at <http://www.acg.edu/programs/>

Grading Policy for Study Abroad Students: DEREЕ academic programs are accredited by NEASC in the US and are validated in the UK by Open University. The College abides to all academic requirements of both accreditors. However, in case an inbound study abroad non-degree student fails an assessment in validated courses but the overall calculated grade is a passing one, that student’s final grade in the course will be the minimum passing grade (grade ‘C’ that is the DEREЕ equivalent to 40 UK points).

Course Level equivalents:

Most DEREЕ courses are designated as Level 4, Level 5, Level 6 (e.g. CS 1070 L4)

Level 4 courses are suitable for sophomores, juniors, and seniors

Level 5 courses are suitable for juniors, and seniors

Level 6 courses are suitable for advanced juniors, and seniors

Non-level designated courses are normally open to all students.
